Driving Directions to Trinity West Hospital: Driving Time Half Hour. Leaving Lake, Turn right onto SR 152 to Richmond, Left onto SR 43, 4 miles to SR 22, Turn left (East) onto 22. Exit Right onto John Scott (Mall, Hospital) exit. Proceed about 3/4 mile to stop light, turn left on Sunset, turn right onto Johnson Road. (Follow International Hospital Signs)

Emergency Phones and Radios: Courtesy Phone for local calls at concession stand and Phone Booth next to 100-ton Sand Pile. Cell phones work at top of Lake Hill. After hours (9 p.m.) phone availabe at the manager's house in an emergency. Emergency calls & messages coming in for campers will be

Emergency Phone located at Concession Stand on Mailbox Post, Silk Stocking Shower Building, Buzzards' Hollow, Buzzard's Tail, and Keyhole -911 + Info to office (24 hours). Lifeguard, management & maintenance carts have communication radios. Ambulance/Fire Dept: Dial 911. Alert Management ASAP

First Aid: AED located at Concession Stand. Other Supplies also at Concession Stand. Limited supplies with lifeguard on beach. First Aid kits and fire extinguishers on maintenance carts.

Ambulance/Fire Department: Dial 911. Alert management ASAP. Emergency 911 & 24-hour phone at Concession Stand Phone Booth, Shower Building, Buzzard's Tail or Keyhole.

**Beach Hours:** Weekends: 11 am - 8 pm, Weekdays: 12 noon - 8 pm. May close due to weather. Children under 12 need adult supervision.

Bowser (Dog) Swimming Area: By Boat Ramp - Bring Bowser to swim! No Humans!

Berg Buster Pedal Karts & Tube Ślide (\$) Buy tickets/rent at concession stand or buy armband Bumper Boats (\$): Buy tickets at First Fish Pond. Open during posted hours, weather permitting Wibit/Rocket Water Playground: Must be 52" & up, able to swim, \$ purchase Armband. Fishing: No charge in all 3 ponds— catch and release, be careful not to harm the fish.

Pay Lake - \$5 Adults, \$2 Children. State license not needed. If keeping, limits on size and

amount posted at concession stand. No night fishing on the lake, ponds okay. If you want to fish early morning and rent a boat, make arrangements the night before. Life jackets mandatory. (PFD) Boat Rentals: Pontoon(\$), Paddleboat(\$), Canoe(\$), Paddle Boards (\$), Kayak (\$ or Armband) Prices listed at Concession Stand window near life jacket shed. Consider an Armband for Kayaks. Deposit (\$) required. Life jackets mandatory. (PFĎ)

Rental Equipment for Park: Horseshoes, volleyball, basketballs, inner tubes, Refundable \$ Deposit or Driver's license needed to rent.

Hiking & Mt. Biking--Take water:

- Big Foot Trail- steep incline to begin, 3/4 mile, great for family, follow marked trail, shorts okay! • Great Blue Heron Rookery- 90% level with short climbs, ends at Great Blue Heron Rookery,
- . Keyhole Trail- steep incline to begin. Trail head in back of primitive camping to the left. Look for open, grassy clearing. Dead ends for turnaround return; can be used as emergency evacuation.
- Buzzards' Hollow Walkabout Trail- Includes hills, follow signs, stay on Austin Lake property.
- Mt. Zion Trail-Head into Turkey Foot and head straight up the hill. Gorgeous but is a climb! **Euchre:** Fridays, 8 pm, Campers' Pavilion, New players welcome.

Hayrides: Saturdays, 7 pm, When you see the tractor coming, stand next to road to be picked up. Several runs will go if wagon is full. May be cancelled due to weather. Responsible adult must accompany children under 12.

Bingo: Usually Saturdays, 8 - 9:30 pm, \$1.50/card all night.

Pancake Breakfasts: Once a month, Saturday 8-10 am. Bring your own table service. No charge (camper organized). Pancakes, syrup, 1 sausage, coffee, milk or juice while supplies last.

#### Helpful Information

**Television:** 7 & 9, Digital southwestern satellite signal, depends on site.

**Propane:** We fill tanks and motor homes 10 am - 8 pm. Pounds or gallons.

Showers Building: Handicap Accessible, 50¢ for 5-6 minutes of hot water, well water limited. Changing table for babies. Silk Stocking Shower House has family restrooms/shower stalls--one stop shop for the whole family. Lines may be shorter in park shower house.

Firewood: Available at concession stand. Will deliver multiple loads.

**Bicycles:** Helmets are encouraged and riding after dark requires a light.

**Speed Limit:** Keep speed to 5 mph. *Enforced!* We have many children, but none to spare. Daily Guests: Guests pay the daily admission fee and must be registered by 7 pm at main gate if staying overnight with a seasonal camper.

Laundry: Coin operated washers and dryers are located inside the Silk Stocking Shower Building. Campers' Pavilion, and Buzzards' Hollow. Bring your supplies or use coin operated soap dispensers. Trash: Receptacles are located throughout the park. Please leave your area clean.

Nature's Pets: Please secure food and trash. Animals will eat unsecured food. Raccoons are wild! Emergencies Campsite Check In/Check Out Times: Check in- after 12 noon (Sunday 4 p.m.) Check out-- Mon-Thurs. 4 p.m.; Fri.-Sat. 12 noon; Sunday 12 noon (if lot not reserved, stay til 4 pm) Early Check in Fee- \$5, if available

Campsite Deposit/Refund: All campsite reservations require a one-night deposit. Holidays paid in full in advance will speed check-in. A \$10.00 handling fee will be charged on all cancellations. A refund will be given to cancellations made at least 14 days in advance.

Cabin Check In: 3 pm Cabin Check Out: Noon-- Respect the times, please!

Cabin Deposit/Refund: All reservations require a one-night deposit at time of reservation. Holidays paid in full in advance will speed up check-in. A \$25.00 handling fee will be charged to all cancellations. A refund will be given to cancellations made at least 30 days in advance.

Early Check in Fee- \$5, if available
