

E-Bike / E-Scooter Rules

- We allow bicycles and E-bikes with pedals. Riders should be pedaling during use.
- We allow stand-on E-scooters. Per Ohio Law, riders must be at least 16 years old, follow traffic laws, and yield to pedestrians. However, riders between 14 and 16 can operate an E-scooter, provided they are supervised by a guardian over 18 who can hear and see them while they ride.
- We allow standard cars, trucks, RVs, street-legal motorcycles, and golf carts. No other motorized vehicles are permitted in the park, including, but not limited to, ATVs (All-Terrain Vehicles), UTV's (Utility-Terrain Vehicles), motorized bicycles, and mini-bikes.
- We allow kiddie cars (Power Wheels). They are to be kept under direct adult supervision on your camp site.
- All riders must obey the posted speed limits and Ohio laws. We reserve the right to take these privileges away for excessive speed, reckless driving, failure to obey rules or verbal requests, repeated requests to slow down, or rude behavior. Parents should closely monitor their children while on any vehicle. We suggest that riders wear helmets.
- Please check your specific homeowner's insurance policy for E-Bikes and E-scooters as there are no specific insurance requirements for these in Ohio. You may be liable for an accident that you cause by your own negligence. Be sure you are insured for liability to others!
